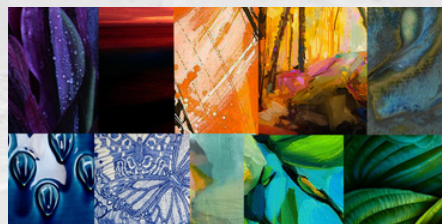

Letter from our President

It is an exciting new year at LeMoyne Arts! Not only have we survived the COVID restrictions on our operations, we have used the down time to reorganize and enhance LeMoyne. We have improved our gallery with new lighting, flooring, and paint. We moved the gift shop to a larger, more accessible space just inside the front door, with a bigger selection of art and unique gifts.

I thank Lori Carlson, our Executive Director during 2020, for steering LeMoyne through the worst of the pandemic and Kelly Dozier for volunteering to serve as Acting Executive Director when Lori retired at the end of 2020.

In December, Mr. Ron Meyer, the owner of the office building on the south side of LeMoyne announced that he was closing his law firm and offered to sell his building to us. We have changed the scope of our Art for Always campaign to include acquiring the building and remodeling it to become our new art education facility. The property includes a 6,000 square foot modern building, 20 off-street parking spaces for visitors, and a small garden space. We plan to have the new art education center open by Spring 2022.

Good news! After last year's COVID cancellation, our Chain of Park Art Festival is back. Artists in the Parks will be on Saturday and Sunday, April 17th and 18th. NOTE: To comply with COVID restrictions this will be a ticketed event. Tickets are free but restricted to specific time slots. Finally, a special thanks to all of you. Your support keeps LeMoyne Arts working, providing art education and promoting interest and participation in the arts in our community.

Art for Always Master Plan Update

You may have read about LeMoyné's efforts to secure funding from the CRA Arts, Culture, and Heritage Facilities Grant which was released in 2018. LeMoyné was the top scorer in the grant review process through which it applied for \$3 million to fund the construction of a new education building and renovated gardens. LeMoyné was ultimately awarded \$1 million of the \$3 million allocated to the various applicants and began a capital campaign to raise the additional funding needed for the project.

This past January, LeMoyné was contacted by the owner of the yellow office building, just south of the gallery, saying that he was selling his building. The building and property at 131 N Gadsden is ideal for LeMoyné's art education facility needs. It will cost \$1 million less to transform into our education center than building a new center. This is wonderful news as LeMoyné is moving forward to purchase this building and will be able to make the renovations much faster than building new. The property also comes with 20 parking spaces, much needed for our students and visitors.

With the \$1 million from the CRA grant in place, LeMoyné is working to raise the remaining \$1.2 million needed to modify the office building into an art education center and to connect the two properties using ADA standards for accessibility and update the gardens so they are fully accessible, beautiful, and open for events for all to enjoy.

The 21st Annual Chain of Parks Art Festival will be held on Saturday, April 17 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Sunday, April 18, 2021 from 10:00am to 4:00pm, at the Bloxham, Lewis and Randolph "Chain of Parks," located in Downtown Tallahassee. Nationally ranked as a Top 100 fine art festival held throughout the country by Sunshine Artist Magazine, art patrons to this year's festival can expect to have a safe, delightful, and fun-filled outdoor cultural experience, while experiencing original and one-of-a-kind works of art in an amazing and enviable Southern outdoor setting.

Other exciting news for the 2021 Festival includes the Zerbe Zelebration, a tribute to Karl Zerbe, a world renowned expressionist artist who taught at FSU and had a significant impact on the visual arts in our community. The Zerbe Zelebration, to be held April 9-18, 2021 is a city-wide collaboration of exhibitions, roundtables, custom Proof beer, and social media interactive experiences. Safety Procedures during the Chain of Parks Art Festival

To control crowd size and adhere to safety guidelines, the festival will be a FREE ticketed event. Attendees will need to reserve a ticket online and select a time slot to visit the artists in the parks. This new ticketing system will include four decorative barricade entrance and exit locations with a color-coded wristband system.

Volunteers will be at each location to check tickets, provide wristbands, direct folks to handwashing/ sanitizer stations, and confirm proper face covering compliance. Masks will be required throughout the festival. The festival will be following CDC guidelines and will have safety precautions visibly placed throughout the event. Family fun activities and focal gathering hubs have been eliminated for 2021. We are thrilled to be able to hold our festival this year and look forward to a normal, fun filled festival in 2022.
