ADULT CLASSES

SOFT PASTEL PAINTING

MONDAYS 6 - 8PM | JOE ROACHE

This class is designed for beginner to intermediate students. If you have some background this can be helpful. This class will provide hands-on instruction in preparing surfaces, color mixing, drawing, and fixing. We will use a variety of techniques from underpainting and watercolor background to alla prima techniques. Students in this class will work from still-life setups, live portrait models, and photographs.

PLEIN AIRE PAINTING

WEDNESDAYS 6 - 8PM | JOE ROACHE

Plein Air painting is a term used to describe the act of painting outdoors. This class will introduce the student to the art of painting landscapes outdoors. In this class, we will work partly in the LeMoyne Arts gardens and the buildings in that area. Later we will decide with the other class members if we want to try some other location(s).

OIL PAINTING

THURSDAYS 6 - 8PM | JOE ROACHE

This class is designed for beginning to intermediate students. If you have some background this can be helpful. This class will provide hands-on instruction in preparing surfaces, color mixing, glazing, scumbling, and using mediums. We will use a variety of techniques from underpainting and glazing to the alla prima technique. Students in this class will work from still life setups, live portrait models, and photographs.





WATERCOLOR & MORE!
TUESDAYS 10 - 12PM | NINA FREEMAN

This is an eight-week class for anyone, beginner or more experienced, who wants to learn more about painting techniques using either watercolor or fluid acrylic on paper. Demonstrations will be provided each class and students will work on their own projects. Instruction in brush techniques, color mixing, composition and more will be provided.

INTRODUCTION TO SCRATCH ART
TUESDAYS 6 - 8PM | CHRISTOPHER BARNHART

This class is an introduction to scratch board techniques. Students will learn skills such as how to create using different materials to scratch and etch images and how to create shadows and highlights using hatching techniques. By the end of this class, you will be able to confidently create anything you would like on scratch board!

STAINED GLASS
SATURDAYS 9 - 11AM | ANDREW MILLER

This class will provide hands-on instruction on how to safely cut glass, solder, and work with lead and copper foil. Students will choose a design, pick out their own glass, and construct one or more windows. All tools and supplies are provided. In addition, I will demonstrate methods for restoring antique stained-glass windows, building lamps using copper foil, working with fused glass, and using Glass Eye Software to make your own designs.



INTRODUCTION TO WHEEL
MONDAYS 2 - 4PM or WEDNESDAYS 1 - 3PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Learn to throw on the wheel! Designed for students brand-new to clay and/or new to the pottery wheel. We will focus on building a strong foundation of skills and techniques that students can carry forward in their ceramics practice. Each class meeting will have a specific focus and students can expect to complete 6-8 pieces (however beautifully wonky!). Class will include discussions of basic knowledge about clay, glazes, and kilns and more!



INTRODUCTION TO HAND BUILDING
TUESDAYS 2 - 4PM or FRIDAYS 2 - 4PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Learn to make with clay! Designed for students brand-new to clay and/or new to hand building. We will focus on building a strong foundation of skills and techniques that students can carry forward in their ceramics practice. Each class meeting will have a specific focus and students can expect to complete 6-8 projects. We'll make everything from pinch pots to garden sculptures! Class will include discussions of basic knowledge about clay, glazes, and kilns and more!





WHEEL THROWING 1

WEDNESDAYS 10AM - 12PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Designed for beginner students with introductory level experience with the pottery wheel. We will focus on mastering the foundational skill of throwing clean, even cylinders and expand into new forms such as bowls and plates. Students will also work on refining their trimming skills to ensure a clean and functional finished pot. Each class meeting will have a specific focus and students can expect to complete 8-10 pieces. The class will include discussions of clay, glazes, and kilns and more!



HAND BUILDING 1

THURSDAYS 2 - 4PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Designed for beginner level students with introductory level experience with hand building and clay. We will focus on mastering foundational skills in slabs, coils, and sculpture by making larger pots and student-designed projects. We will also explore surface design through the creation of tiles. Classes will be a combination of specific projects and student-led ideas. Students can expect to complete 2-3 larger projects. The class will include discussion of clay, glazes, and kilns and more!

YOUTH & TEEN CLASSES



TEEN TREASURES, TRINKETS & JEWELRY

SATURDAYS 2 - 4PM | MOLLY KILCREASE

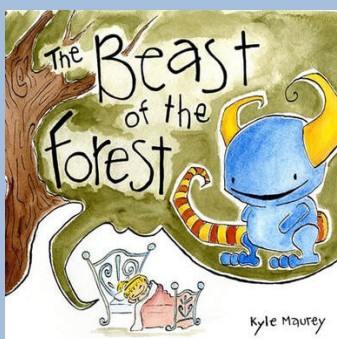
This class is for beginning sculptors who will be given the opportunity to explore different approaches to working with clay! This class will explore and foster foundational ceramics hand-building techniques and skills as well as cover glazing, and preparing work to be kiln fired.



YOUTH CREATIVE COLLAGE

TUESDAYS 4 - 6PM | MOLLY KILCREASE

In this youth art class we will explore the potential of collage, learning techniques and building the skills needed for creating layered artworks. Students will explore print making, painting, and other techniques while learning how to layer and combine elements to create a cohesive masterpiece!



YOUTH INTRO TO STORY ILLUSTRATION

THURSDAYS 4 - 6PM | KYLE MAUREY

This class will introduce the basics of children's book illustration. We will begin with story ideas and sketches before moving on to mapping out our own books. After exploring and planning, we will complete at least one fully illustrated spread of your story and you will leave with the structure to keep creating.

From the nifty 1950s to the gnarly 1990s and everything excellent in between we will experience it all through art making!
