A Note from the Creators:

A non-profit organization (since 2022), Women Among Us Inc. has created a photographic and narrative series about women 65 and over in the Big Bend area. Through our exhibitions and community outreach, we hope that these women will be seen, but also recognized and valued. They are women who have dedicated themselves to what they love doing for decades.

How do we age? How can we represent the process of aging? What does aging mean for a life of meaningful achievements and contributions.
