

CLASSES



Try new mediums in art and expand your skills!
We have several different class offerings exploring a wide array of focuses.
These classes meet once a week and most sessions last for eight weeks.

WATERCOLOR & MORE
TUESDAYS 10 - 12PM | NINA FREEMAN

This class is for anyone, beginner or more experienced, who wants to learn more about painting techniques using either watercolor or fluid acrylic on paper. Demonstrations will be provided each class and students will work on their own projects. instruction in brush techniques, color mixing, composition and more will be provided.



INTRODUCTION TO WHEEL

WEDNESDAYS 10 - 12PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Designed for students brand-new to clay and to the pottery wheel. We will focus on building a strong foundation of skills and techniques that students can carry forward in their ceramics practice. Classes will discuss basic knowledge about clay, glazes, and kilns that will give students a holistic understanding of ceramics.



INTRODUCTION TO HAND BUILDING

THURSDAYS 2 - 4PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Designed for students brand-new to clay and hand building. We will focus on building a strong foundation of skills and techniques that students can carry forward in their ceramics practice. We'll make everything from pinch pots to textured bowl molds! Classes will discuss basic knowledge about clay, glazes, and kilns that will give students a holistic understanding of ceramics.



STAINED GLASS

SATURDAYS 9 - 11AM | ANDREW MILLER

This class will provide hands-on instruction on how to safely cut glass, solder, and work with lead and copper foil. Students will choose a design, pick out their own glass, and construct one or more windows. In addition, I will demonstrate methods for restoring antique stained-glass windows, building lamps using copper foil, working with fused glass, and using Glass Eye Software to make your own designs.



BEGINNING DRAWING

MONDAYS 6 - 8PM | JOE ROACHE

This basic drawing class will provide hands on instruction in drawing, from basic sketching through finished drawings and portrait sketches. We will use a variety of different mediums including pencil, charcoal, pastel, and color pencil mediums. Students in this class will work from still life setups, live portrait models, and photographs.



FIGURE DRAWING

WEDNESDAYS 6 - 8PM | JOE ROACHE

This class is designed for beginners! This basic figure drawing class will provide hands-on instruction in drawing, from basic sketching to finished drawings and portrait sketches. We will work using a variety of different mediums including pencil, charcoal, pastel, and colored pencil. The class will use models and photographs.



OIL PAINTING

THURSDAYS 6 - 8PM | JOE ROACHE

This class is designed for beginning to intermediate students. If you have some background this can be helpful. This class will provide hands-on instruction in preparing surfaces, color mixing, glazing, scumbling, and using mediums. We will use a variety of techniques from underpainting and glazing to the alla prima technique. Students in this class will work from still life setups, live portrait models, and photographs.

TEEN & YOUTH CLASSES



TEEN TREASURES, TRINKETS & JEWELRY

SATURDAYS 2 - 4PM | MOLLY KILCREASE

This class is for beginning sculptors who will be given the opportunity to explore different approaches to working with clay! This class will explore and foster foundational ceramics hand-building techniques and skills as well as cover glazing, and preparing work to be kiln fired.



YOUTH ART FROM THE HEART: MULTIMEDIA

SATURDAYS 1:30 - 3:30PM | LINDSAY MERRILL

Students will learn a variety of mediums from drawing and painting to pen and ink, through fun and engaging projects. This class will help kids begin to understand the basic elements of art by creating multiple art and craft-based projects.



YOUTH CERAMICS

WEDNESDAYS 1 - 2:30PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

This class will explore the wonderful possibilities of clay with the goal of giving students a foundation in ceramics. Students will learn to build with coils, attach little faces to garden buddies, and the steps to make their own stamps! Students will complete five total projects in the class.

In this youth art class we will explore the possibilities of paper art, learning techniques and building the skills needed for creating both 2D and 3D works of art.
