ADULT CLASSES



OIL PAINTING MONDAYS 6 - 8PM | JOE ROACHE

This class provides hands-on instruction in preparing surfaces, color mixing, glazing, scumbling, and using mediums. We will use a variety of techniques from underpainting and glazing to alla prima, impasto, pouring, and collage techniques. Students in this class will work from live models, still life setups, and photographs.



INTRODUCTION TO WHEEL THROWING MONDAYS 6 - 8:30PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Come learn to throw on the wheel! We will focus on building a strong foundation of skills and techniques that students can carry forward in their ceramics practice. Each class meeting will have a specific focus and students can expect to complete 6-8 pieces. The class will also include discussions of basic knowledge about clay, glazes, and kilns that will give students a holistic understanding of ceramics.



WATERCOLOR & MORE TUESDAYS 10AM - 12PM | NINA FREEMAN

This is an eight-week class for anyone, beginner or more experienced, who wants to learn more about painting techniques using either watercolor or fluid acrylic on paper. Demonstrations will be provided each class and students will work on their own projects. instruction in brush techniques, color mixing, composition and more will be provided.



COLOR THEORY & PRACTICE WEDNESDAYS 6 - 8PM | JOE ROACHE

This course will introduce students to the many factors related to color in painting. Subjects such as hue, value, saturation, and color interaction will be covered. The student will complete various exercises that will help to understand each color process.



MIXED LEVEL HAND BUILDING WEDNESDAYS 1:30 - 4:30PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Let's make things with clay! We will focus on foundational skills in slabs, coils, and sculpture in a series of instructor-guided and student-led projects. We'll make everything from pinch pots to garden sculptures. Students will also work on building their surface design skills through the creation of tiles. The class will include discussion of clay, glazes, and kilns that will give students a holistic understanding.



SOFT PASTEL PAINTING THURSDAYS 6 - 8PM | JOE ROACHE

This class is designed for beginning to intermediate students. Some background in drawing can be helpful. This class will provide hands on instruction in preparing surfaces, color mixing, drawing and fixing. We will use a variety of techniques from underpainting to creating watercolor backgrounds. Students in this class will work from still life setups, live portrait models, and photographs.



WHEEL THROWING 1 THURSDAYS 6 - 8:30PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

We will focus on mastering the foundational skill of throwing clean, even cylinders and expand into new forms such as bowls and plates. Students will also work on refining their trimming skills to ensure a clean and functional finished pot. Each class meeting will have a specific focus and students can expect to complete 8-10 pieces. The class will include discussions of clay, glazes, and kilns that will give students a holistic understanding of ceramics.



LITTLE BIT OF EVERYTHING CLAY FRIDAYS 6 - 8:30PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Don't know whether to start with hand building or wheel throwing? This is the class for you! We'll explore both through a series of guided projects including wheel-thrown spoon rests and hand-built trinket boxes. A great introductory or one-time class for folks interested in exploring clay as an art form.











SKILL DEVELOPMENT STUDIO SATURDAYS 9AM - 12PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Looking to practice your ceramics skills? Join the Skill Development Studio! Students will focus on improving their wheel throwing or hand building skills in this small group environment. We'll work on setting goals, creating timelines, and record keeping. Designed for students interested in learning how to move from beginner to intermediate skill levels in their work.

INTRO TO STAINED GLASS SATURDAYS 9 - 11AM | DREW MILLER

This class will provide hands-on instruction on how to safely cut glass, solder, and work with lead & copper foil. Students will choose a design, pick out glass, & construct one or more windows. All tools and supplies are provided. Includes demonstrations of methods for restoring antique stained-glass windows, building lamps using copper foil, working with fused glass, and using Glass Eye Software to make your own designs.

STAINED GLASS MOSAIC MULTIPLE CLASS OPTIONS AVAILABLE | SHEA WEBB

A mosaic is a surface decoration made up of closely set, usually variously colored, small pieces of glass, tile, ceramic, or stone. In this class students will construct their own mosaic using a design of their choice. Everyone will learn to safely cut or break the glass then assemble pieces on a flat surface using glue and grout.

CONSTRUCTING A STEPPING STONE MULTIPLE CLASS OPTIONS AVAILABLE | SHEA WEBB

Steppingstones for the yard or garden can be handmade and decorated with bits of glass, ceramic, or other objects. In this class, students will cast their own steppingstone out of mortar, then prepare a mosaic decoration for the surface and secure it with grout. Everyone will learn to safely cut or break the glass, mix mortar, and apply the grout.

WORKSHOPS



TRIMMING ON THE WHEEL SKILL BUILDING WORKSHOP SUNDAYS, DECEMBER 10 & 17 | 10AM - 2PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Come spend time in the ceramics studio with Laurel Blackthorne practicing your wheel throwing and trimming skills. Our first meeting will focus on throwing consistently and cleaning and the second on trimming defined feet and adding texture. Students have the option to have their work bisque fired and ready for pickup in the new year.



GLAZE LAB SUNDAY, JANUARY 14 | 10AM - 2PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Bring any unfinished bisqueware and glaze in time for the new year! Utilize LeMoyne's colorful collection of glazes and underglazes to give your work the final pop of color needed to make it complete! Pieces will be available for pickup 1-2 weeks after the lab.



SURFACE DESIGN 1: LUSTERS WORKSHOP SUNDAY, MARCH 3 | 10AM - 12PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

In this workshop Laurel will guide you through using metallic and pearl lusters. Luster is an overglaze, applied over the vitrified, glaze-fired piece and requires a special third firing. Laurel will be available to answer questions and assist as you experiment with the technique. Please bring your glaze ware for this workshop!



SURFACE DESIGN 2: SGRAFFITO WORKSHOP SATURDAY, MARCH 9 | 10AM - 12PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

In this workshop Laurel will guide you through sgraffito, a pottery decorating technique produced by applying layers of color to leather hard pottery and then scratching off parts of the layers to create contrasting images, patterns and texture and reveal the clay color underneath.



GLAZE LAB SUNDAY, MARCH 10 | 10AM - 2PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

Bring any unfinished bisqueware and glaze in time for the new year! Utilize LeMoyne's colorful collection of glazes and underglazes to give your work the final pop of color needed to make it complete! Pieces will be available for pickup 1-2 weeks after the lab.



SURFACE DESIGN 3: UNDERGLAZE TRANSFER WORKSHOP SATURDAY, MARCH 23 | 10AM - 12PM | LAUREL BLACKTHORNE

In this workshop Laurel will guide you through using underglaze transfers to decorate your work. Underglaze transfers are made up of ceramic underglaze material that has been printed onto thin paper.


YOUTH & TEEN CLASSES
