Artist Bio:

A Tallahassee native, Eluster Richardson began painting as a child and has received numerous awards for his paintings, including LeMoyne's Chain of Parks Art Festival 2022 "Best in Show". Eluster has exhibited in a variety of museums and galleries. Collections of his work can be seen at

the Custom House Museum in Clarkesville, Tenn., Polk County Museum of Art in Lakeland Fl., Riley House Museum/Center, Gadsden Art Center Museum in Quincy, All Children's Hospital in St. Petersburg, Fl., Florida League in Tallahassee and Leon County Libraries (just to name a few).

Words frequently used to describe Eluster's work include "uplifting", "inspiring", and "enlightening". Eluster is fascinated by local history, particularly the people and places of North Florida, inspiring the body of his work. Eluster is well respected in the local art community, treasured by local historians and private collectors. His most recent series of work include a Quilting Series and a Forgotten Coast Series of landscapes. Eluster has been involved with LeMoyne Arts for several decades and continues to be a cherished partner.

Artist Statement:

It is difficult to explain the spirit that haunts me and compels me to draw and paint. My journey of hard work and a passion for the arts is ongoing, as you will see in this exhibition. In my quilting series of paintings there is something fascinating to me about patches of colors all placed together like stars in the sky. There is also a challenge in bringing those colors together in the rules of composition. My quilting theme is dear to my heart because the quilts you see in these paintings are inspired by my mother's quilts.

This exhibition also explores the beauty of how sunlight seems to travel across the marsh grass in my landscapes of the Forgotten Coast, inviting the viewer to see a palette of warm colors.

There is an intimate, personal moment of reflection through the artwork that I have explored in this exhibition.
