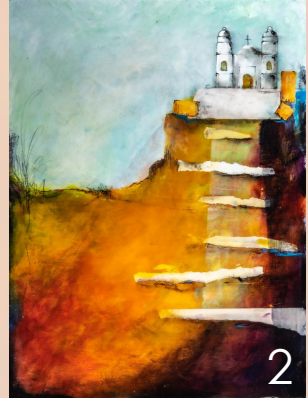


Leslie Anderson



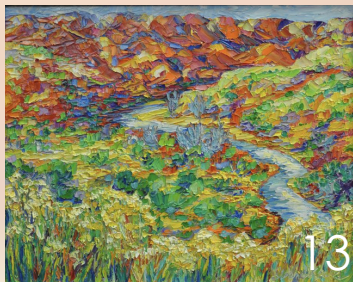
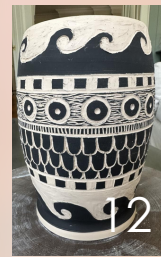

Moving to Florida in the mid '80s to continue her education, she received a bachelor's degree in Interior Design and a Master's in Art Education and Art Therapy at Florida State University. Combining her passion for teaching and art, Anderson worked for the public school system as an art teacher for over 29 years; she retired in September 2020.

Her experience in interior design, art education, and the day-to-day work being a full-time art teacher have allowed her to work on various mediums, however, her passion has always been painting. These past years, as her two children left home, she found the needed time and space to pursue her art. She loves working with color. Leslie reflects "Color can provoke enormous reactions in people; this only intensifies with the addition of playful and in many cases seductive lines in my work."

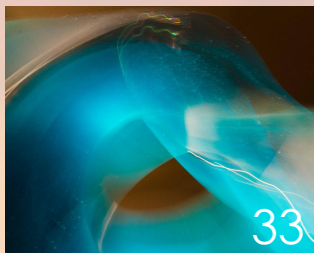

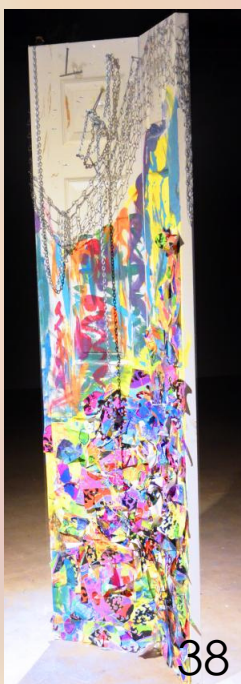
