CLASSES




Try new mediums in art and expand your skills! We have several different class offerings exploring a wide array of focuses. These classes meet once a week and most sessions last for eight weeks.

Deep dive into a new technique! Our workshops are a great opportunity to get your feet wet and create a beautiful piece of art. These workshops are offered throughout the session.





ABSTRACT ACRYLIC PAINTING

MONDAYS 6-8 PM | JOE ROACHE

This class is for beginner to intermediate students and will be directed toward making abstract paintings using acrylic paint and other mixed media. Students will learn to prepare surfaces, color mixing, glazing, scumbling, and using mediums. A variety of techniques will be used, from underpainting and glazing to alla prima, impasto, pouring, and collage techniques.



FIGURE DRAWING

WEDNESDAYS 6-8 PM | JOE ROACHE

This class is designed for beginners! This basic figure drawing class will provide hands-on instruction in drawing, from basic sketching to finished drawings and portrait sketches. We will work using a variety of different mediums including pencil, charcoal, pastel, and colored pencil. The class will use models and photographs.



OIL PAINTING

THURSDAYS 6-8 PM | JOE ROACHE

This class is designed for beginning to intermediate students. This class will provide hands-on instruction in preparing surfaces, color mixing, glazing, scumbling, and using mediums. We will use a variety of techniques from underpainting and glazing to the alla prima technique. Students in this class will work from still life setups, live portrait models, and photographs.



WATERCOLOR & MORE!

TUESDAYS 10 AM-12 PM | NINA FREEMAN

This class is for anyone, beginner or more experienced, who wants to learn more about painting techniques using either watercolor or fluid acrylic on paper. Demonstrations will be provided each class and students will work on their own projects. Instruction in brush techniques, color mixing, composition and more will be provided.



INTRO TO STAINED GLASS

WEDNESDAYS 6-8 PM | ANDREW MILLER

This class will provide hands-on instruction on how to safely cut glass, solder, and work with lead and copper foil. Students will choose a design, pick out their own glass, and construct one or more windows. Other methods will be demonstrated, including restoring antique stained-glass windows, building lamps, working with fused glass, and using Glass Eye Software to make your own designs.



CREATING WITH CLAY

THURSDAYS 5:45-8 PM | NANCY JEFFERSON

Come join us at LeMoyné for fun with clay in our ceramics studio! All techniques of hand-building and wheel throwing will be explored. From functional to sculptural, the sky is the limit as to what you can create! Going outside the box is our forte. If there is something special you wish to make, Nancy will show you how!



DIGITAL ARTS (TEEN)

SATURDAYS 12-2 PM | SAMUEL SHELLEY

This course will teach the fundamentals of digital illustration in Adobe Photoshop. Students will learn the elements of art, how to operate and configure their pen and tablets, and how to use Photoshop for all stages of the illustration process. They will also learn how to use various tools and effects in Photoshop (creating brushes, layer blending, filters, etc.).



ART FROM THE HEART (YOUTH)

SATURDAYS 1:30-3:30 PM | LINDSAY MERRILL

Students will learn a variety of mediums from drawing and painting to pen and ink, through fun and engaging projects, as well as how to translate their ideas creatively. This class will help kids begin to understand the basic elements of art like line, shape, form, composition, and color theory by creating multiple art and craft-based projects.



FRUIT AND NATURE PRINTING (YOUTH)

SUNDAY AUGUST 21 10-12:30 PM | ANGELINA RODGERS

Celebrate the beauty of nature by making inspired prints! In this workshop, we will explore nature and printmaking processes to create masterworks, using plants, fruits, and veggies. Young artists will be able to create dynamic compositions, develop printmaking skills, and explore color with this art making adventure!



NATURE INSPIRED LINO CUT PRINTING (TEEN/ADULT)

Explore and capture the intricacies of nature by making inspired linocut prints! This workshop will utilize nature motifs and printmaking processes to create a series of artworks. With the linocut printing process students will carve, ink, and print multiples of their artwork featuring plants, fruits, and veggies, while creating textural, colorful prints and developing printmaking skills!
