## The 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Mahaska Whitley High School Show: LeMoyne Arts Awards nearly \$4,000 in Scholarships *Exhibition on view through March 30, 2019*

**Tallahassee, FL – (March 9, 2019)** Over 400 students, parents, teachers, and special guests from the community gathered at LeMoyne Arts for the 32nd Annual *Mahaska Whitley High School Exhibition Opening Reception & Award Ceremony* that took place on the evening of **Thursday, March 7th**. High school students across Tallahassee had an opportunity to enter their art into this highly-anticipated competition for a chance to win awards ranging from gift cards to scholarships. This local tradition is open to all Leon County high school age students from public, private and home schools. **This year LeMoyne Arts awarded nearly \$4,000 to the winners.**

Award categories include; *Emerging, General and Senior*. This year LeMoyne Arts debuted the *Matt Callahan Memorial Scholarship Award*, that was established in memory of Matt Callahan, a talented artist who tragically lost his life in 2018.
